

~Shock wells and get water system offline. Main Campus (Pritchard House, Infirmary and Bath House) can be done ASAP. (Peter, Greg and John)

~This is a good learning/teaching opportunity for all involved.

~Repair any/all damage to water system, fixtures, toilets, etc... At least 1 toilet in Boy's bathroom needs repair and 1 sink in girls needs help. Anyone with plumbing skills should bring appropriate tools.

~Begin work on bathroom in Pritchard House. Remove all plumbing lines from basement to 2nd floor bathroom... Cap lines where appropriate so we can winterize the rest of the system.

~Begin removal of laundry room ceiling and determine extent of damage....

~Pick up debris from around the camp and get mowers, spin trimmers, blowers and chipper running..... Anyone with small engine experience, grinder for blades, would be welcome!!

~Limited chainsaw work is needed, but some dead trees need to be dropped.

**** Please bring a shop-vac if you have one.... I'd like to vacuum the water out of the toilet tanks and bowls before flushing with antifreeze. A small amount of anti-freeze needs to be put into toilets and tanks.

~Get all bathrooms offline, sweep, mop, secure window,

~Prep Pritchard house bedrooms, infirmary bedrooms and McBurney bedrooms for guests..

~Make sure all cabins are swept, dusted, cleaned, and ready for guests.

~Pull all emergency lights down and remove batteries...

~Hang new curtains in each of the back family cabins. (confirm with Marilyn Russel)

~Clear low lying debris, brush and saplings from all walking areas. All debris must be cleared!!

DO NOT throw debris into the woods!!

~Treat cabin floors with remaining sealer from Fall work weekend. (Old clothes strongly advised)

~Check fuel levels on all propane tanks!!!

~Order propane delivery if needed. (They only come through White Lake 1 time each week, so we need to get on the schedule early if this is needed).

~Bring dishwasher online, clean all utensils from the day and then shut down, break fittings, and prepare winterization by draining water tank and then filling with antifreeze.

~Replace any/all non-working light bulbs in all buildings.

~Fix or replace wobbling light/fan in dining hall. (Front table by ramp)

~Run and fill clothes washers in Pritchard House and McBurney Trailer with antifreeze.

~Remove/Replace broken fencing around quad area.... Not sure of rebuilding at this time, but removal can be done.

~Arrange chairs and tables in dining hall and rec. hall.

~Split firewood if appropriate

**** VERY IMPORTANT**** If anyone is/has gone up to the camp, it is imperative that all circuit breakers (both Main and panel breakers) must be in the "off" position. The power company can bring the camp online remotely if this is done. I'll have the power turned back on once I know the preferred weekend date.
